A Level 1 test will be required to pass the course.

The curriculum is based on the need for proper gear/equipment and begins teaching proper decision making skills. A Level 2 test will be required to pass the course.

Designed to train new and current WCOs, the courses provide classroom instruction with hands-on shooting range experience. Professional instructors provide intensive training in shooting accuracy, special safety considerations and effectiveness in shooting in non-traditional shooting locations. Participants will experience high level training in ballistics, shot choice and placement, and overall firearm use suitable for wildlife damage management. Please bring your own long-rifle (caliber must be no smaller than .17 HMR and no larger than .30 cal), at least 200 rounds (factory loads only!), personal eye and ear protection. (400 rounds if taking both Level 1 & 2)
