Please take extra care and precaution as you go about your work this week following the significant snowfall across the UK.

Shaun Davis, head of safety, health, wellbeing and sustainability, said: 'Please ensure that you take the appropriate precautions. Check the local weather forecasts regularly and complete a dynamic risk assessment where appropriate.

'Please remember to wear PPE. That's really important. Make sure you adhere to severe weather risk assessment controls. If it isn't safe – or doesn't feel safe – don't do it. And, if driving in severe weather, make sure you drive slowly and leave a large gap behind the vehicle in front.

'The materials on the severe weather support site can be used to prepare and inform colleagues of the precautions they can take when faced with severe weather.'
