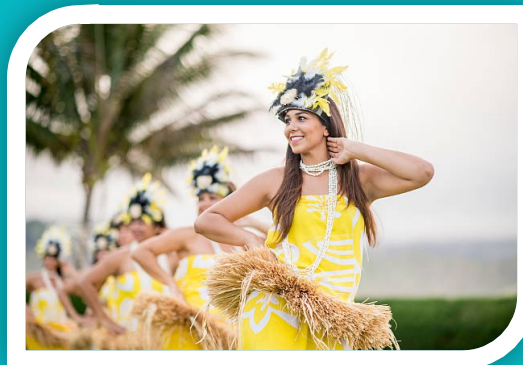

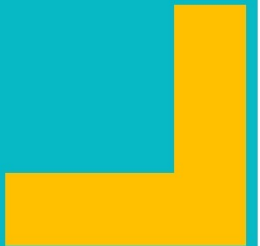

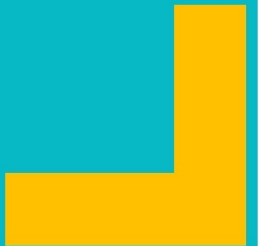




TRIP BACKGROUND

- COVID suspended travel

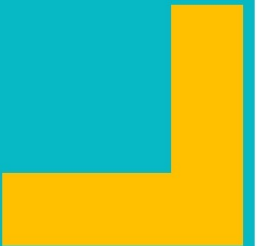

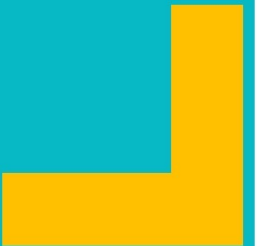
- Trip of a lifetime!

Day 1:

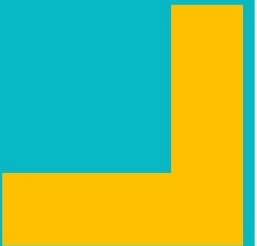
Wednesday, April 3rd (D)
