^{*} For every applicant, a \$4.20 processing fee is charged per program to offset the cost of our online application system. Certain courses require lab fees; these are noted in the course descriptions (see website or flyers).

At all summer programs, students enroll for either the half day (morning or afternoon) or the full day for the duration of the program. The daily schedule for most students is two classes each morning and/or two each afternoon; they choose their own courses from a variety of exciting topics (see individual program flyers on website). See "Details" downloads on our website (left margin of the home page) for information specific to each program. All courses are designed to challenge and inspire for the length of the programs in which they are offered; however, students who feel they would be happier switching to a different class after the first day or two are free to do so as space allows.

Applicants who have attended previous programs of The Center for Gifted are accepted upon application. Three items: a teacher recommendation, the eligibility checklist for parents (both of which are forms that can be downloaded from our website, from links on left margin of the home page), and a copy of the student's most recent report card are required for applicants who have not attended a previous program. More information is provided on our summer 2019 Eligibility Requirements pdf, which also can be found on our website or emailed or mailed upon request. The three required documents may be submitted via fax, mail, or email, before, with, or after application.

There are no application deadlines. Enrollment remains open for each program until it begins or until the program is full; some programs have limited enrollment.

A deposit of at least \$80 must accompany application for all programs except Project '19, which requires a \$150 deposit. Tuition and fees are fully refundable for withdrawals requested from any program before it begins. Financial assistance is available for our summer programs, based on need. Please contact us for the application.
