The Court, having received and reviewed the Application for Order to Show Cause filed by Phoenix Newspapers, Inc. and Kathy Tulumello (together “Plaintiffs”), and having considered the arguments therein and the arguments presented by all parties during the April 26, 2022 hearing on Plaintiffs’ Application for Order to Show Cause,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants Douglas J. Logan and Meghan M. Logan (collectively, the “Logan Defendants”) have obligations co-extensive with those of Cyber Ninjas, Inc. to cause the public records identified in Exhibit 10 to Plaintiffs’ Amended Complaint for Statutory Special Action to Secure Access to Public Records (the “Public Records”) and any related logs of withheld documents to be produced in accordance with the requirements of the Order to Produce Public Records dated August 24, 2021, as modified and/or clarified on September 22, 2021 by Minute Entry, as modified and/or clarified on October 11, 2021 by Minute Entry, as modified and/or clarified on November 30, 2021 by Minute Entry in Case No. LC2021-000180-001, *Phoenix Newspapers, Inc. et al. v. Arizona State Senate, et al.* (collectively, the “Earlier Orders”).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Logan Defendants are required to comply with the obligations to produce the Public Records and any related logs of withheld documents as set forth in the Earlier Orders promptly, and on a rolling basis. The Logan Defendants first tranche of Public Records and any related logs of withheld documents are to be produced to the Arizona State Senate or Plaintiffs in accordance with the requirements of the Earlier Orders by **Friday, May 6, 2022**, with subsequent productions of additional Public Records and any related logs of withheld documents to occur every **five** court days

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7 to comply with their obligations pursuant to this Order.
