Fieldwork in AFPRL

- AFPRL established in 1969 in the context of the civil rights movement
- AFPRL resulted from students demands for:
 - a more inclusive curriculum that represented the student body
 - faculty to teach these courses
 - library resources
 - existing fieldwork courses moved to AFPRL

Fieldwork as Service Learning

Two-fold goals that meld **theory and praxis**:

- 1. Strengthening the department's and college's connection to the larger New York City community
- 2. Prepare students to apply coursework to a real world context
