Stan Bland serves as the Pavement Applications Director for the Southeast Cement Promotion Association (SCPA), formerly the Portland Cement Association. He graduated from Clemson University with a BS in Civil Engineering in 1971 and is a registered Professional Engineer in South Carolina. Mr. Bland began his career at SCDOT as a resident engineer in 1971, spending time in various management and supervisory roles throughout his tenure. In 2011, he retired from SCDOT as the State Pavement Reclamation Engineer with 40 years of service and joined the SCPA. In 2004 Stan was awarded the Asphalt Recycling and Reclaiming Association Special Recognition Award and in 2011 was awarded Honorary Lifetime Membership into this organization.
