EXECUTIVE SUMMARY


Dallas ISD's improved STAAR outcomes from 2021-22 are also reflected in Domain 1 increases.

- **Goal 1:** Domain 1 results *increased by 6 points* year-over-year (all grades/subjects for STAAR/EOC)
- **Goal 5:** Domain 1 results *increased by 8 points* year-over-year (middle grades, all subjects for STAAR/EOC)

To recover fully to pre-pandemic Domain 1 results and be on track to 2025 goals, Dallas ISD sees continued need for learning acceleration.

Goal 1 - Dallas shows substantial growth, returning to 2017-18 results. Accelerated growth needed to reach pre-pandemic (2018-19) levels and be on track to 2025 goals.








Accelerated growth needed to reach the 2025 target for Goals 1 and 5
