The ICAA Workshop introduces classical architecture as a living language. The program begins with architectural case studies that demonstrate the use of classical forms and design strategies in new buildings and places. Participants are then guided through a series of hands-on drawings by professional architects that demystify the forms and systems of classical architectural composition. The program provides instruction for students who are just beginning to explore the language, as well as for more advanced level participants and those who have attended previous ICAA Workshops.
