- Please indicate if your program has included any modification that specifically address the impacts of COVID-19 or Social Justice and Racial Equality efforts.
- Applications must be metrics-driven programs that have existed for at least one fiscal year, highlight measurable data, and offer plans for sustainability.

During this time, OMYF will **not** accept unsolicited grant applications or requests.

This application is non-transferable, please do not forward.

OMYF Grant Cycle Timeline:

- March 3, 2021: Grant applications electronically distributed to invited participants
- April 6, 2021: OMYF will host a virtual roundtable session to discuss the 2020-21 grant cycle
- **May 7, 2021: Completed applications must be submitted electronically to OMYF by 5:00 p.m.**
- May 10, 2021: Grant application reviews and financial audits begin
- June 2021: OMYF Board of Directors meeting to review/approve grant funding recommendations
- June 2021: Agencies are notified of their grant status
- June 2021: OMYF Grant Ceremony
