What Will Participants Receive?

- Interaction with peers from across the country
- Virtual field trips to national historical sites
- A stipend of \$600 for teachers and \$150 for students and a certificate of completion

Who Can Apply: This opportunity is for high school American history and civics teachers and high-need* high school students, preferably students going into the eleventh or twelfth grade in the fall of 2021. In order to enhance collaboration and planning of joint civic engagement activities in the ensuing academic year, we ask that teachers and students from the same school or district apply in teams of one teacher and two students.
