## Public Law 101–283 101st Congress

## An Act

May 9, 1990 [H.R. 3802]

To designate May 1990 as "Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## SECTION 1. ASIAN/PACIFIC AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH.

92 Stat. 920.

The text of Public Law 95-419 after the resolving clause is amended to read as follows: "That the President may issue a proclamation designating May 1990 as 'Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month' and calling on the people of the United States, especially the educational community, to observe such month with appropriate ceremonies, programs, and activities.".

## SEC. 2. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.

The title to Public Law 95-419 is amended to read as follows: "Joint resolution authorizing the President to designate May 1990 as 'Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month'.".
