### Hello Patriots!

The 2023 FCPS School SAT day will be on March 1st at Governor Thomas Johnson High School for ALL eligible Juniors. Please review this document carefully as it includes valuable information regarding the SAT.

## **BEFORE March 1:**

- Create a College Board Account- Visit <a href="www.collegeboard.org">www.collegeboard.org</a> and click Sign up to get started.
- Practice for the SAT- Visit <a href="www.sat.org/practice">www.sat.org/practice</a> for free resources to help you prepare.
- Review "What's on the SAT"- Visit https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/whats-on-the-test
- Identify up to four colleges where you would like to send your scores. Each student can send your score to four colleges for free on test day.
- Identify where your testing room is located by asking your connect teacher before March 1st.
- All Testing Room locations will also be published on the Main Office and Guidance Office Windows.
- All testing rooms will be located in the upstairs of the humanities wing.

# On TEST DAY: March 1

- Eat breakfast- You need fuel for your body and brain to function.
- Report to your Testing Room no later than 7:30AM.
  - o Testing Room Locations will be posted on Main Office and Guidance Office Windows.
  - All students will report to their testing rooms for attendance.
  - o Students that arrive after testing begins (7:45AM) will not be permitted to enter test rooms.
- Bring two #2 pencils with a soft eraser and a College Board approved calculator.
- Bring extra batteries for your calculator.
- Bring a photo ID to be placed on your assigned desk prior to testing.
- Snacks and water are permitted during breaks. These items must stay under student desks and away from test materials at all times.
- Students may not have electronic devices (cell phones, smartwatches etc..) in their possession at any point during the test. Leaving them at home or in vehicles eliminates the need for the proctor to collect them.
- Testing time is 3 hours and 30 minutes. Beginning and closing directions add to the administration time. Testing is anticipated to be completed around 11:30AM.

### **AFTER March 1**

- Check your College Board account regularly for the release of student scores.
- Verify with colleges that your free score sends arrived at the desired locations.
