
2023 Delegate Allocation

The new (approved in 2022) basis for calculation:

The number of delegates is 140, cap on states of 10 delegates and a threshold for at least two delegates at 300 members.

The yellow column is the 2023 allocation for each state. The gray columns below are for comparison.

Summary of changes due to the 2022 Bylaws change:

19 states with between 319-969 members gained 1 delegate. TX (-3) and NY (-1) were reduced to meet the new cap of 10.

Summary: 31 had no changes. 21 changes: 19 are +1, 1 is -1 (NY), 1 is -3 (TX), -2 (VA)
