## Introduction

Oral health is crucial for overall health and well-being, yet global inequities in oral health pose a significant burden, impacting **3.9 billion people worldwide**. Access to dental care remains an unmet health need, particularly among children.

# **Project Description**

**Solidarity Dental**, in collaboration with **Novulismed** SA (Novulis), aims to provide affordable, comprehensive on-site oral care to underserved and remote areas of Ecuador. Through mobile and portable dentistry, Solidarity Dental will facilitate communication, implementation, and execution of dental outreach in partnership with Novulis.

#### **Focus Areas**

<u>Clinical and General Health Impact:</u> Assess the overall health outcomes of dental care and education provided to low-income families and children.

<u>Oral Health Literacy:</u> Research to enhance understanding of patient satisfaction with on-site family strengthening, dental care, education, and Oral Health-Related Quality of Life (OHRQoL).

**OHRQoL:** Determine the impact of oral health interventions on employee absenteeism, turnover, productivity, and well-being.

**Economic Impact:** Explore the financial impact on patients and employers resulting from improved access to oral health care by conducting a benefits analysis.

# Capstone/Deliverables Examples

- **a)** Develop an evaluation strategy to answer research questions and guide the final evaluation.
- **b)** Study and report on the clinical and economic impact of improved access to oral health care for Ecuador's vulnerable population.
- **c)** Analyze data, interpret results, and advocate for legislation and policies supporting access to oral care, reducing barriers, improving oral health literacy, and fostering partnerships.
