Academy of Peer Services (APS) Terms of Use

The New York State Office of Mental Health provides funding to offer the course work contained in the Academy of Peer Support (APS). Acceptable Use Policy

- 2. I will use only legal versions of copyrighted software in compliance with licensing agreements to access and complete courses.
- 3. I will use appropriate and respectful language in all communications to APS staff and fellow APS learners .
- 4. I acknowledge that the APS policy prohibits the creation of multiple accounts using different email addresses to establish those accounts.
- 5. I will not attempt to bypass security protocols to establish an account in the APS.
- 6. I will honor all copyright and intellectual property guidelines when accessing published materials, conference presentations, videos, websites, and course content.
- 7. I will not use any of the aforementioned resources unless I adequately acknowledge the source of the material.
